EURASLIC was founded in 1988, and for more than 30 years the organization connects librarians and information specialist from European aquatic science institutions by providing forum for sharing ideas and discussing issues of common interest, improving dissemination of aquatic information, supporting joint projects, encouraging cooperation within Europe and building links with other national, regional and international aquatic science libraries and information networks.

Since its foundation the conferences are held every two years and so far they had been organized in 17 European cities. The conference brings together librarians and information specialists from aquatic libraries at research centres, universities, government agencies and the private sector in Europe and from countries in bordering regions, as well as representatives of international organizations. The conference provides a valuable opportunity for the exchange of ideas and expertise, and experiences in the dissemination of the relevant information in that field.
